Procedure for trips abroad

Travel & Accommodation

Under 13's (Minors Level) U'11's and U'9's

Players will need to be accompanied by a Parent/Guardian in all cases. Alternatively, parents should make arrangements for their child to travel with a designated adult and contact the airline to arrange for their child to be connected to that parent/adult.

Players traveling without parents, but with a designated adult, must bring a letter to authorise them to travel with the group.

Players will share a room with their parent/guardian or designated alternative adult.

Under 15 (Intermediate Level) and Schoolboys

Players will share rooms with their team mates. A minimum of 2 players and a maximum of 4 players will stay in each room.

Parents/guardians will stay in individual rooms, separate from the players.

The above may be changed depending on the hotel availability.

Team Managers & Daily Program

A team Manager will be appointed for each team on each trip.

The Head coach will issue a daily program for the trip regarding times for each day showing the times for;

- Meals
- Training
- Games
- Bed time
- Wake up

This daily program will be issued to all parents and players at the airport or at the hotel.

It is the Manager's responsibility to ensure daily program is followed and to take responsibility of all actions off the rink. The Parents should support the Manager in ensuring that their child adheres to this.

During the day all players are in the supervision of the Manager and Parents should not take their child/children away from the supervision of the Manager.

However, the parent/guardian or designated adult of players Minor's level and below, will be responsible for them after dinner until breakfast time next day.

Training/Games

During training and games only the Manager and Coaches should be in the dug out area. Parents are welcome to the sports centre spectator area to support and cheer the team.

Behaviour

Players are being assessed at all times for their suitability to play for England National Teams. The behaviour of players is a factor in this assessment, so therefore please remember that we represent England at all times and disciplinary action may be taken for any bad conduct.

Concerns

Any concerns raised by any player or parent should be reported in the first instant to the team Manager.
